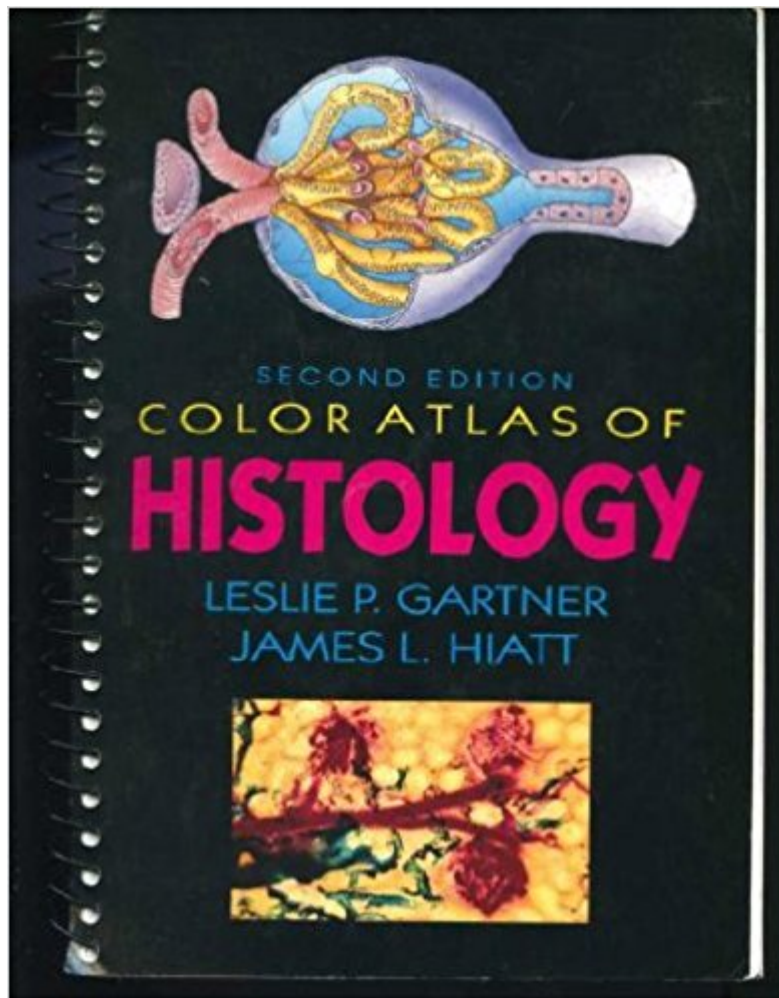


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# Color Atlas Of Histology



## Synopsis

This atlas of histology is aimed at medical, dental and allied health students for use in the laboratory, as well as to give assistance for practical and didactic exams. Each chapter begins with a discussion of the structure and function of the tissue or organ system and ends with a functional summary, which allows students to see the connection between the anatomy and physiology of the subject matter presented in the chapter. Photomicrographs are arranged from low power overviews to higher magnifications. New to this edition are key terms in bold and a two-page spread of 3D artwork with accompanying narrative in each chapter, which should bring an added dimension to parts of the body students are viewing in a single dimension under the microscope.

The atlas was excellent and easy to refer to. The text, while usable, is brief and has much more information than was necessary at my undergraduate medical level. I recommend using this as an atlas and using a different text (such as Wheater) for accompanying explanations.

Good book to have to supplement the Basic Histology Text and Atlas by Luiz Carlos Junqueira. Provides brief explanations and more pictures to assist you with identifying things under the microscope.

Clear images, very good internal organization of sections (bold font key on the inside cover flap is very helpful), and semi-glossy pages that don't cast glare on the figures in normal classroom lighting. Note: Pages are not as glossy as magazine pages, so they are vulnerable to water damage - but less so than the pages in cheap paperback books.

I had a hard time grasping histology as a MS1 and bought this book to supplement my reading. Easy to read and helps quite a bit for the Histology shelf exam. A good supplement for in-class lecture notes.

The flow of the text and pages is horrible. The font is huge and causes you to read and scroll through through 10 different pages as opposed to three in the hard copy. The pictures and their captions are on separate pages so its really hard to compare while reading caption because you have to keep flipping back and forth and the fact that you can't ZOOM into pictures makes this WORTHLESS!!!!!!!!!!

I recommend this book for those who are seeking a basic introductory book to histology. The chapters and content have a nice flow, and illustrations complement the diagrams very well. There aren't a lot of special stains featured, but more focused on basic H&E.
