

I always try to have a look inside books before buying one. Before buying this Atlas, I compared it with DiFore, BRS Cell biology and histology, Wheater's and others. I was a little skeptical but after receiving the book I was glad to have chosen this one. The text is excellent with all the required basic histology as well as pertinent clinical implications. I also liked the diagrams, electron Scans and images. Some reviewers have said that the images are not as good as some other atlas but I don't agree with them. I have studied this Atlas in detail for understanding histology for USMLE exams and I didn't see any deficiency in the images, diagrams and Scans and it clarified my concepts of many things which I didn't know before despite passing Step 1 and Step 2 CK exams. For the first time it clarified my understanding of the structural and functional histology of Bone, hematopoiesis, lymphoid organs (specially Lymph nodes and Spleen organization), Skin, Connective Tissues, and Cellular organelles like details of Ribosomes, mitochondria, golgi cisternae and the rough and smooth endoplasmic reticulum, though I had studied those chapters in other histology books and atlases. One thing I liked the most is the initial chapter of different types of Stains and Microscopies (e.g. Dark Filed, Light, Fluorescent, Scanning Electron, Transmission Electron etc) and immunohistochemical techniques. That was the main thing which helped me in understanding the ways we study and interpret histological organization and details. The only complaint I have is with the ink used in the printing of the text.
